Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Sunday morning live streamed from the church. Recordings of services uploaded onto our website and Facebook page. Church groups met in person. Kirk Session meetings held in person. Elders kept in regular contact with members via telephone and home visits. Weekly Bible studies led by members of the congregation. Local primary school held end of term services in the church. Finance team monitored financial matters and advised the Kirk Session. Kirk Session oversaw the maintenance of our buildings. An elder represented the charge on the Inverness Presbytery serving on the Congregational Mission Committee.

Charities supported: Church members helped provide and serve afternoon teas at Forres St Leonard's Church as part of the Forres area churches Christian Aid Week. We held a fundraising concert in conjungtion with the RAF Band raising funds for the RAF Benevolent Fund and Moray Food Plus. We also supported Moray Food Plus from our Harvest Service with both cash and food donations. Lent collection for Church of Scotland Syria appeal, carol sining collection for Erskine, Christingle service collection for the Children's Society and our Christmas Eve retiring offerings went to Crisis and Wateraid. The Guild held a soup lunch raising funds for the Starchild and Pioneers Guild projects.
